



Community for Children Six-Month Interview - Discussion Guide

1. Looking back on the Community for Children rotation, what had the greatest impact on you?
2. What is the most significant change you have made to your practice of medicine/public health as a result of your experience with the Community for Children rotation? *[Outcome: insight into how the learner was changed through the experience]*
3. What made you identify this change as the most important one? *[Outcome: insight into the learner's values about the experience]*
4. How was the re-entry process after you completed the program? Were you able to tell your story? *[Purpose: understand potential challenges to applying lessons]*
 - Did coming back into the demands of life, school, and medicine keep you from continuing to reflect upon or integrate your experiences?
5. How have you integrated ways to continue with reflection and/or self-nurturance?
[Outcomes: understanding the personal challenges they will face if they want to be leaders for advocacy work.]
6. What do you wish you could help your colleagues understand about patients who are poor or who lack access to health care? About working with communities? *[Outcome: understanding of how to advocate for patients]*
7. Describe any advocacy work you have done since leaving the rotation. If you have not done any, what do you plan or hope to do in the future? *[Outcome: commitment to advocacy work]*
8. What are the barriers that physicians face in doing advocacy work? *[Outcomes: understanding the challenges they will face if they want to be leaders for advocacy work.]*
9. Are there ways that the faculty could provide ongoing nurturance in your growth as a physician?
[Outcome: commitment to advocacy, as shown in their desire to stay in the Community for Children network?]
 - If so, what contact would be helpful?
 - Are you willing to be a resource for this program in the future?
10. In hindsight, what were the most valuable experiences in the Community for Children elective?
[Process assessment: What elements of the program worked]
11. What changes do you think would make the elective even better? *[Process assessment: What elements of the program worked]*
